- The windward mark White Red Bull buoy (1) and off-set mark small red buoy (2) will be present at the windward mark to be rounded starboard.
- The downwind mark is a gate which must be passed between the two marks (3p) and (3s) Large Orange buoys and can be rounded either on port or on starboard side.
- o A boat needs to go through the gate before the finish line.
- The start line is between the starting vessel displaying orange flag and Large Orange buoy with Orange Flag.
- The finish line is between the starting vessel displaying blue flag and Large Orange buoy with blue Flag
- Other possible courses (see appendix) will be shown on the notice board at the veranda of the clubhouse of the HKZV and/or explained during the skippers briefing.

  - (c) When 9, 10, 11 or 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

(d) When 13 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 21.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.






Addendum B shows the location of the racing areas.
