1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) .

- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.3 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

- 1.5 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, applies for Hobie Dragoon

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on 26 June 2026 at 23:59.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at www.hkzv.nl/event
- 3.2 [DP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats with valid [Texel rating](#) certificates
- 4.2 The Texel rating system applies to boats racing under open class.
- 4.3 Classes are defined as follows:

Open Large class	Texel Rating <107	
Open Small class	Texel Rating >106	

- 4.4 Boats may enter the event by registering online before June 26, 2026 at www.hkzv.nl/event using the application form.

- 4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.6 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Double Standard Fee
- 4.7 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Rescue boats

6 CREW LIMITATIONS

- 6.1 The following crew limitations apply: (under the age of 18 years) the crew needs to be able to right the boat by themselves in all weather conditions.

- 7.1 The organizing authority may provide bibs or tracking devices that competitors are required to wear as permitted by the World Sailing Advertising Code.

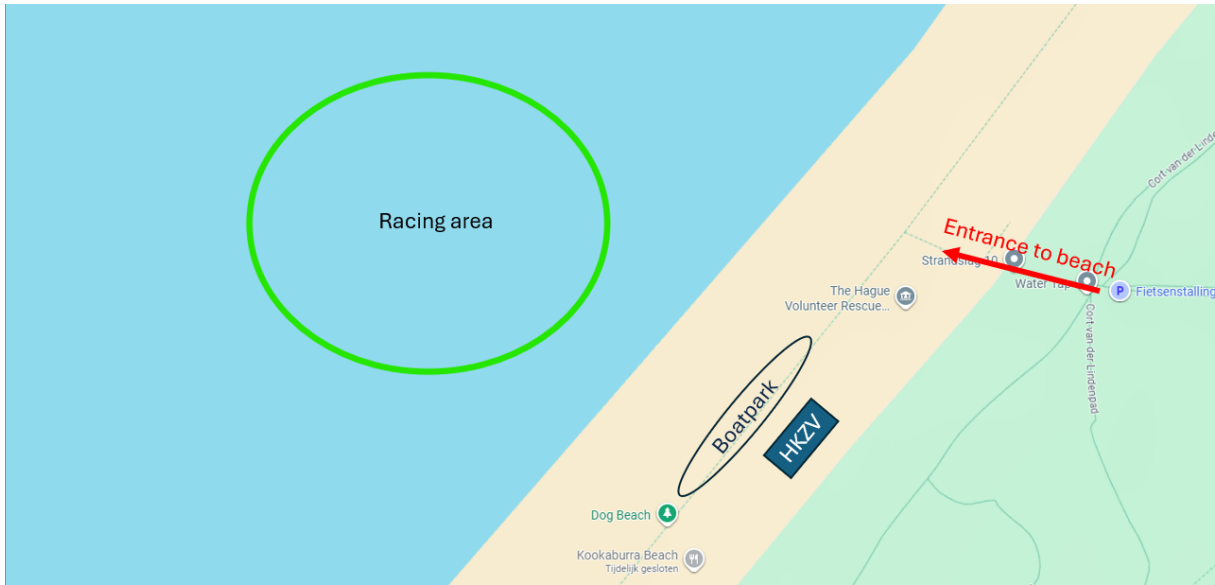

10.2 Plan of the event venue and racing area

The event venue will be located around the HKZV clubhouse.

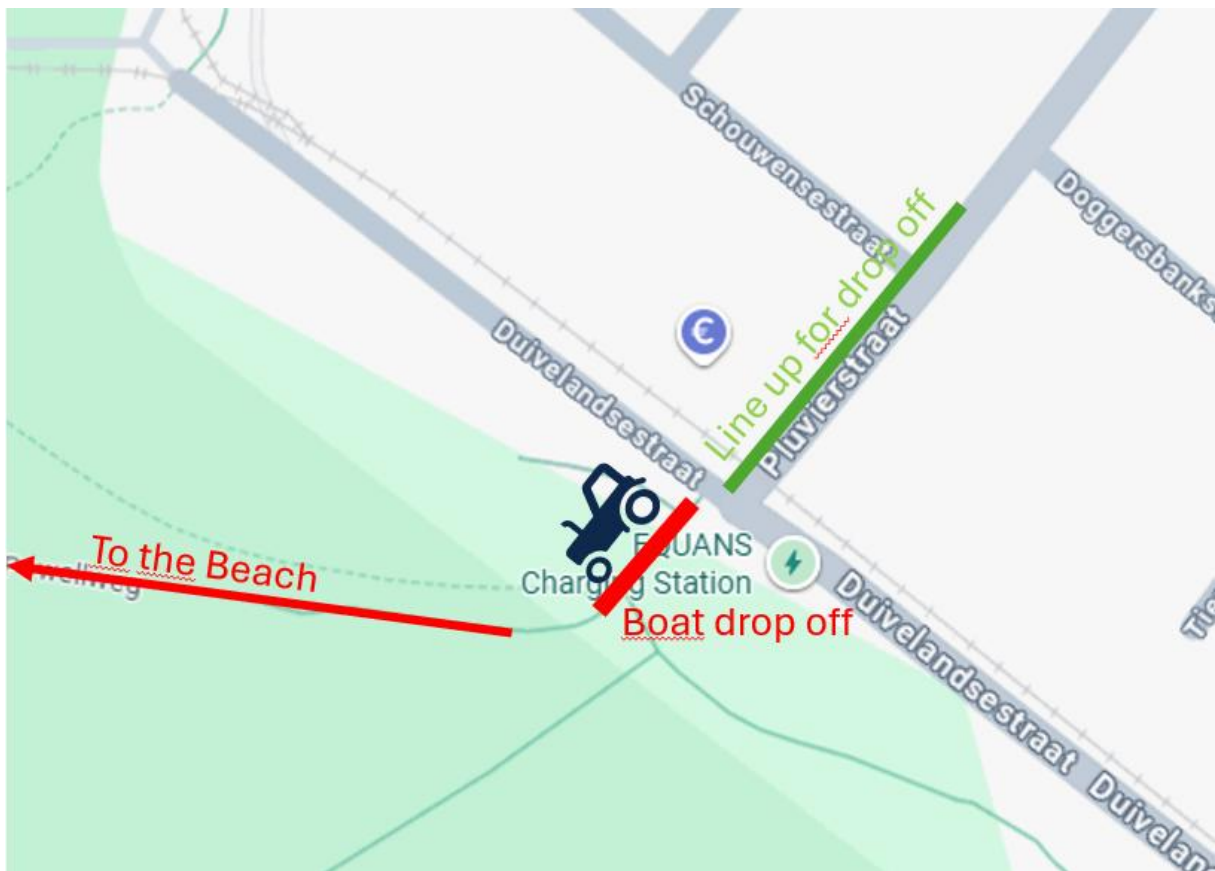
The racing area will approximately be in front of the clubhouse. Near the S1 buoy. Coach boats can be launched from the beach of Scheveningen Harbour. There will be more detailed information at a later date.



10.3 Boat drop off location for transport to the beach

Driving through the Dunes with the car is prohibited.

Please line up in Pluvierstraat, near the Pluvierstraat/Duivelandsestraat crossing for transport to the beach. Try not to disrupt public transport (tram & bus)



11 COURSES

11.1 The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Up Down Courses (Inner/outer loop)

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 12.1** For All class(es) RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

13 SCORING

- 13.1** Three races are required to be completed to constitute a overall winner.
- 13.2** (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
(c) When more than 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

This changes App A 2.1

- 13.3** RRS 90.3(e) applies, only for the final results.

14 [DP] SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 14.1** Support person vessels shall be marked with Coach.

15 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

- 15.1** A chartered or loaned boat may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules, provided that the race committee has approved her sail identification before the first race.

16 [DP] BERTHING

- 16.1** Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park:

Catamarans are located at the beach boat park and coach boats can be park in Scheveningen harbour. More information on this to follow.

17 RISK STATEMENT

- 17.1** RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 17.2** The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 INSURANCE

- 18.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

19 PRIZES

19.1 Other prizes will be given as follows:

Hobie 16 class prize & Hobie 16 best Youth
Hobie Dragoon floating trophy
Other classes 1, 2, 3 and best under 17
